Potatoes sold for table use from the 1961 crop amounted to 154,834,000 hundredweight, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Sales for table use varied only a small amount during the period 1956-60, with a gradual increase from 146,048,000 hundredweight during the 1956 season to 149,199,000 hundredweight during the 1960 season. Production varied from a low of 242,522,000 hundredweight in 1957 to a high of 293,594,000 hundredweight in 1961.

The amount of fresh potatoes used for processed food items such as chips, frozen products, dehydration, and canning continued to increase--51,987,000 hundredweight from the 1961 crop in comparison with 48,973,000 from the 1960 crop and 40,106,000 hundredweight from the 1959 crop.

Usage of 1961 crop potatoes for livestock feed, starch and flour amounted to 39,411,000 hundredweight. This was 2.5 times the 15,525,000 hundredweight used from the 1960 crop and was 13 percent of the total 1961 production.

Processors of potato chips and shoestrings took about 43.4 percent of the potatoes processed for food items from the 1961 crop. Potatoes used for making chips and shoestrings amounted to 22.6 million hundredweight compared with 21.0 million hundredweight from the 1960 crop.

Potatoes used for making frozen French fries from the 1961 crop increased 19 percent from a year earlier and totaled 15.9 million hundredweight against 13.4 million from 1960. Processors of flakes, granules, diced, and other forms of dehydrated products used 8.5 million hundredweight, a decrease of 16 percent from the 10.1 million from the 1960 crop. The volume potatoes used in other food items was 12 percent greater than the amount a year earlier.

Processors of starch and flour handled 20.5 million hundredweight of the 1961 crop, twice the amount processed during the 1960 season and 11 percent above the 18.4 million hundredweight from the 1958 crop. During the 1961 season, 16.3 million hundredweight moved to starch and flour under the government diversion program.

On a fiscal year basis (July 1, 1961 to June 30, 1962) potato chippers used 2.5 million hundredweight compared with 20.6 million hundredweight for the comparable period ending June 30, 1961.
